The Solemnity of St. Timothy

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 28, 2018

We praise and thank the Lord for the gift of St. Timothy in our church. He surely is a God-sent to us as a wonderful example in our effort to follow Jesus and as a fitting guide in our mission to continue to make our parish united in faith and mission. As we pray and reflect our Christian life, these following reflections might be helpful:

1. The word Timothy means "honoring God" or "precious to God". These are very true in the life of our saint. How true are these in our lives? Aren't all lives precious? In what ways we show honor to God?
2. St. Timothy has a sincere faith in God. His grandmother Lois and mother Eunice helped him grow in trust in the Lord. As parents and elders to the young, how are we communicating our Christian faith to them? Is passing our faith a priority in our bucket list?
3. St. Timothy's familiarity with the Jewish and Greco-Roman cultures and his knowledge of Judaism and the Hebrew scriptures made him an ideal coworker with St. Paul in his missionary journeys. His mother is a Jewish and His father is a Greek. What are the benefits and challenges of being in a diverse community? What God-given gifts have we willingly shared for the good of the church and for the glory of God? Can we work together as a body of Christ like St. Paul, Silas, and St. Timothy?

St. Timothy was faithful, active, and trustworthy coworker- let us be God's instruments too.

Su madre es Judía y su padre es griego. ¿Cuáles son los beneficios y desafíos de ser una comunidad diversa? ¿Qué dones recibidos de Dios hemos compartido voluntariamente para el bien de la iglesia y para la gloria de Dios? ¿Podemos trabajar juntos como cuerpo de Cristo como San Pablo, Silas y San Timoteo?

San Timoteo fue fiel, activo y un trabajador de confianza. Seamos nosotros instrumentos de Dios también.
