ONE FLOCK

Jesus adds another feature to the shepherd imagery, which was also disturbing to his disciples. He refers to "other sheep which do not belong to this fold," who will become part of the same flock. This likely refers to the Gentiles, to all peoples beyond Israel. The Shepherd extends his flock, but emphasizes that there is still only one flock. Jesus spoke forcefully and frequently, especially in the Gospel of John, of the importance of unity among those who follow him.

We who follow Jesus are expected to embrace the "other sheep," to respect and celebrate differences among Christians. We are expected to learn from one another. All those things that seem to divide Jesus's followers in culture, ethnicity, or history of conflict fade in comparison with the deeper unity of the one flock under one Shepherd. Living in unity is essential for us to be faithful and credible witnesses of Christ to the world.

UN REBAÑO

Jesús añade otra característica a la imagen del pastor, la cual también inquieto a sus discípulos. Él se refiere a "otras ovejas que no son de mi rebaño" pero serán una parte del mismo rebaño. Esto probablemente se refiere a los gentiles, a otros pueblos más allá de Israel. El Pastor aumenta su rebaño, pero enfatiza que solo hay un solo rebaño. Jesús habló con fuerza y frecuentemente, especialmente en el Evangelio de Juan, de la importancia de la unidad de aquellas personas que lo siguen.

Nosotros, quienes seguimos a Jesús, debemos de recibir a "las otras ovejas" para respetar y celebrar las diferencias entre los cristianos. Debemos de aprender del otro, de la otra persona. Todas estas cosas que parecen dividir a los seguidores de Jesús en la cultura, la etnicidad o los conflictos de la historia se desvanecen en comparación con la unidad más profunda de un solo rebaño con un solo pastor. Vivir unidos es esencial para que seamos testigos fieles y creíbles de Cristo en el mundo.

St. Timothy's Conference

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is an international Catholic voluntary organization of lay people, men and women. Founded in Paris more than 180 years ago has its main vocation to follow Christ through service to those in need and bear witness to Jesus' compassionate and liberating love.

Today, St. Vincent de Paul volunteers visit the homes of the working poor, seniors and the unemployed to lend a hand and a heart during a time of crisis. SVDP has Homeless Centers locally in South San Francisco, Redwood City, Daly City and in San Mateo where our kind deacon Abel Mejia is the director. The society collaborates in jail services with a chaplain and take part in The Restorative Justice Service.


Here at St. Timothy's Conference we serve 20 to 35 families a month. Last year we helped with \$8,368 in rent and utilities; \$4,198 in clothes and furniture vouchers; \$4,475 in Safeway gift cards; and \$36,000 in food value. At our conference we try to live the charism of St. Vincent who said "God demands first the heart, then the work". It is only with our heart that we can bring compassion, respect and devotion to the destitute and marginalized. It is only with a heart on fire with God's love that service can become mission.
