TWO GARDENS

The independent streak in every human heart can resent rules and regulations. We often rebel against the idea of blindly following rules we did not create for ourselves. We have inherited this willfulness from Adam and Eve, who could not resist eating from the one tree God strictly outlawed in the Garden of Eden. Jesus, fully human and fully divine, personally understands our desire to do things ourselves. In his own garden, the garden of Gethsemane, Jesus transformed human history. Instead of following his own inclinations, Jesus offered his decision-making, his free will, his very life, to God. As the Gospel of Luke tells us, Jesus was in such agony and he prayed so fervently that his sweat became like drops of blood falling on the ground. Observing God's law is not easy, not even for the Son of God. But Jesus promises that keeping God's words will bring us peace. Jesus' submission led to resurrection; our obedience will calm our hearts, allowing God to dwell deep within.

En su propio jardín, el jardín de Getsemaní, Jesús transformó la historia humana. En lugar de seguir sus propios sentimientos, Jesús ofreció su decisión, su libre voluntad, su propia vida a Dios. Así como el Evangelio de Lucas nos dice lleno de angustia, oraba más intensamente, y comenzó a sudar como gotas de sangre que corrían hasta el suelo. Obedecer la ley de Dios no es fácil, ni siquiera para el Hijo de Dios. Pero Jesús promete que guardar la Palabra de Dios nos traerá paz. La entrega de Jesús guió a la resurrección, nuestra obediencia calmará nuestros corazones, permitiendo que Dios habite en lo profundo.

SOMETHING TO PONDER...

Intercessory Prayer – What is it?

Prayer is one of the most natural and joyous functions of a spirit-filled life. The power of the church to bless rests on intercession. It is our instrument to impart spiritual blessing to others.

In Christian practice, intercessory prayer is the act of one person praying for or on behalf of another. One study Bible defines intercession as “holy, believing, persevering prayer whereby someone pleads with God on behalf of another or others who desperately need God’s intervention.” It is praying with the real hope and real intent that God would step in and act for the good of some specific other person(s) or other entity. It is trusting that God will act, even if it is not in the manner or timing we seek. God wants us to ask, even urgently. It is casting our weakness before God’s strength, and (at its best) having a bit of God’s passion burn in us.

In intercessory prayer, the pray-er offers one's self and one's prayer as a channel through which God's deliverance can reach those in need. The intercessor becomes a link between heaven and earth, between God and His creation. The power of intercession is magnified when intercessors pray together or at the same time.
